Students have to buy the whole book as we use almost all chapters. The book can be purchased in paperback.

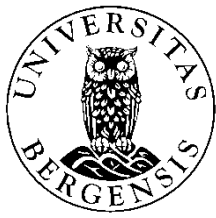

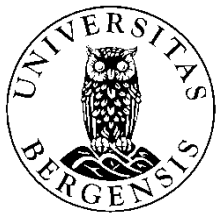
